



# Summer Activities for Incoming Presidents

## Financial Activities

- **Year end audit** – The fiscal year end for PTA is June 30 and should be completed by the outgoing (2013/2014) Unit Auditor. Audits should be completed as soon as possible during the summer months to allow for the incoming treasurer to get started with the 2014-2015 records. Two copies of the year end audit will be due at our first meeting in September.
- **Annual Financial Report** – Your current Treasurer is responsible for completing the Annual Financial Report. This report is available under “PTA News/Forms” and is for the period 7/1/2013 – 6/30/2014. It is also due at the first meeting in September. If you have any questions on this report, contact CUCPTSA Treasurer.
- **2013-2014 Taxes** – Once the June 30, 2014 Audit is complete, Federal taxes for the unit may be compiled. A paid preparer may be used – this cost should be included in the 2014-2015 Budget. Taxes are due on November 15. Be sure to follow the regulations for the 2014 taxes. - **Check Signing Authority** – You must visit your bank during the summer to complete new bank authorization signature cards based on your incoming board. Check in Article VI Section 5 (g) in your bylaws to determine who can and cannot sign checks. All units should require two signatures on all checks.
- **2014-2015 Budget** – During the summer months the incoming president must meet with the new treasurer and board to develop a proposed budget for the coming year.

## Training:

All incoming presidents, treasurers and secretaries are *required* to complete one of the training classes offered at Convention, by Fourth District in the Spring or by Council to insure that they are familiar with PTA policies and procedures. If you or your officers were not able to attend the State Convention or were not able to attend the Spring Training, Fourth District PTA will hold training sessions in September. Please plan to attend!

## Unit PTA Website:

Update your PTA website with 2014-2015 school year information after school is out in June. Include the new Board and Association Meeting dates.

## Unit Meetings:

The Council President will request a list of you unit Association Meetings for the Council website. Please submit the dates and times of your meetings (Association only, not executive meetings) in the summer BEFORE school starts.
